The difference between the professional and the DIY option:

Issue/Problem	DIY Option	Professional Cleaning
Hand Wiping or Dusting	Uncomfortable, some dust removed and some spread around.	All dust is gently removed
Grease, Nicotine, Dirt, etc.	A portion is cleaned but most is smeared around causing discoloration and odor.	All contaminates are eliminated leaving no discoloration and no odor.
